

## Counsellor Programme

### Who can file an application?

Senior managers of university facilities who effectively and efficiently integrate their respective work units into fields of international teaching, research and development co-operation

### Which measures are fundable?

Measures which improve the innovative effect of and the sustainable structural improvements to the teaching, research or service-providing expertise that can be achieved at the foreign partner university by the proposed measures (e.g. curriculum development, module development, improvement to the research capability, optimising the university management, creation of technology transfer centres and service centres, etc.).

### For what time period and to what extent is funding provided?

Over a period of two calendar years, the DAAD can fund up to a maximum of four assignments at a partner university by any one German academic or expert. Each assignment can last between a minimum of two weeks and a maximum of three months.

- Travel expenses for German advisers;
- Subsistence expenses for German advisers;
- Equipment grants for small devices and material for the disposition in the partner country (once in two years).

Since networking between partners and third parties is seen as a key component of the programme, short stays in Germany and, in justified exceptions, stays in a third country by up to three staff members from the partner university may be subsidised through grants.
